



# WANT TO HELP AS A POLL WORKER?

- You must be a registered Delaware County Voter
- Be able to work from 5:30am to approximately 8:30pm on Election Day
- Have own transportation to/from your working location
- Including your paid training, set-up and Election Day, you will earn an average of \$150
- You cannot work in a precinct where you or a relative are on the ballot
- You must not have any felony convictions unless reversed, expunged or pardoned
- High School Seniors can also serve if they are at least 17 years old
